Registration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The registration desk will be located in the lobby of the John Niland Scientia building. It will open at 4pm on Thursday 12th April and will remain open during conference session hours.
Assistance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please ask any of the volunteers at the registration desk.
Food	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea will be served every day and are included in the registration fee. Welcome reception will be held Thursday evening with drinks and canapés served during the poster session. Drinks and canapés will be served during Friday poster session.
Transport	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> UNSW Gate 9 Bus stop on High Street is the closest to the conference venue. The buses stopping directly at this stop are M50 (Coogee-Railway-CBD-Drummoyne), 370 (Coogee-Leichhardt), & 400 (Bondi Junction-Airport-Burwood). Please note that you must have a ticket before you board M50 or any other Metrobus buses, or when you board any route at a PrePay only bus stop. For more transport information go to www.131500.com.au Other buses from the City Centre: From Circular Quay these bus routes pass through the city along Elizabeth Street and then along Anzac Parade to the UNSW Anzac Gate entrance: routes 390, 391, 392, 394, 396, 397, 398, and 399. From Central Railway Station: Bus Routes 391, 393, and 395 travel to the UNSW Kensington campus. From the Airport: Bus route number 400, traveling between the airport and Bondi Junction passes along Anzac Parade and stops at the Anzac Gate and High Street, Gate 9. The journey takes around 30 minutes. Taxis <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A taxi from the city costs around \$20 and takes around 15-20 minutes for the journey. A taxi from Central Railway Station takes 15-20 minutes and costs around \$20. A taxi from the airport costs around \$25.00 and takes 20-25 minutes.
Parking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Parking on campus is only by UNSW permit or Pay and Display ticket, between the hours 7:30am to 7:30pm Monday to Friday (except public holidays). All day parking is available on the upper floors of the Barker St (Gate 14) and Botany St (Gate 11) car parks; Pay & Display ticket machines accept cash or credit card. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pricing: minimum \$6 for 3hrs, and \$2.50/hr thereafter up to 12hrs (cash and credit card payments) Short-term meter parking is available through most Gates and is located at ground-level outdoor parking areas. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pricing: 2P short-term parking = \$3.50 per hour (cash and credit card; minimum credit card payment is \$3.50)

Information for Presenters:

Spoken Presentations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• There will be four streams of spoken presentations on each day of the conference. Please consult the programme, and Map for the location of each stream;• With the exception of presentations within symposia, talks should last for 15 minutes with an additional 5 minutes for questions and changeover. Spoken presentations will begin promptly at the scheduled time.• Presenters: Please check the timing of your presentation prior to the conference. Please arrive 10 minutes before your session to transfer your slides to the laptop in your room and to meet the session chair. After transferring your slides to the computer, please check that your presentation software is operating correctly. Mac/Keynote users, you will be able to connect your laptop, but you must bring your own, and any set-up time will be part of your allowed speaking time (please don't forget your mini display port to VGA plugs). Please let us know if you have additional audiovisual requirements (e.g., sound).
Session chairs	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Please arrive at least ten minutes early to introduce yourself to the speakers, and to ensure that the session will begin on time. You will be provided with sheets of paper labelled 5 minutes and 1 minute to assist you in keeping speakers to time.
